




Series Downloads are comprised of MP3 audio files compressed (zipped) into a single file (zip file).



To extract the MP3 files, right click the .ZIP file and select "EXTRACT ALL." If you do not have the "EXTRACT ALL" option your computer should give you an alternative method to extract the files.




Select a destination folder to extract your MP3 files to.




## Open iTunes.

- 1. In Windows Explorer, select all your extracted MP3 files.
- 2. Sort your extracted files by TYPE to group all the MP3 files together.


3. Do not select the .DOC and the HELP.PDF file contained in the .ZIP file.




Drag the selected MP3 files into your iTunes Music Library.




In iTunes, select File > New Playlist




## Enter a name for your New Playlist



In iTunes, select "Music" under the LIBRARY section in the left column.



- 1. You can filter your iTunes library by typing the name of the series that you downloaded into the Search Music box (1).
- 2. Select the files from the series and drag and drop them onto the new play list you created.



Ensure your iPod/iPhone/iPad device is connected to your computer.


- 1. Select your iPod/iPhone/iPad device in iTunes.
